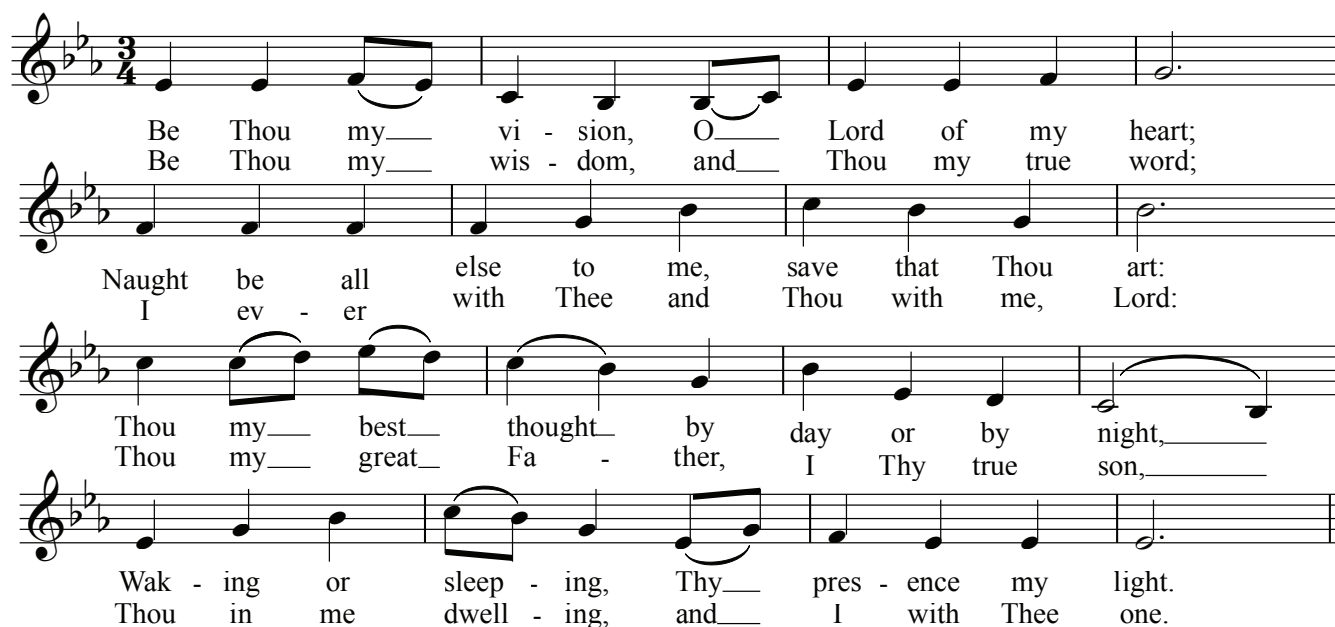

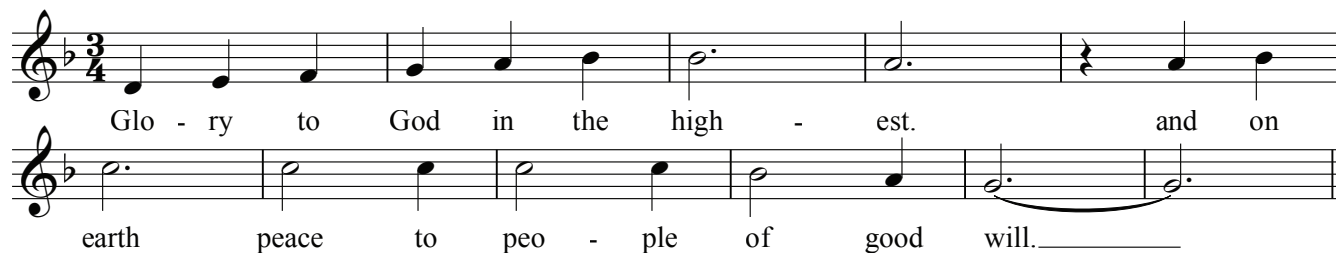
GATHERING SONG.....Be Thou My Vision
