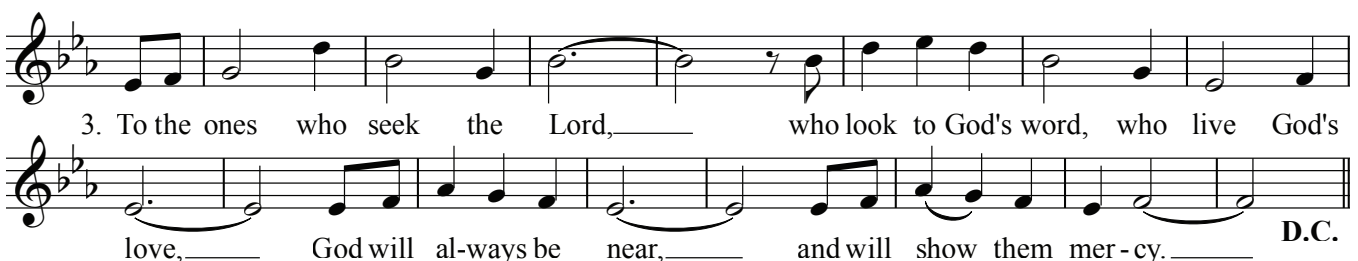
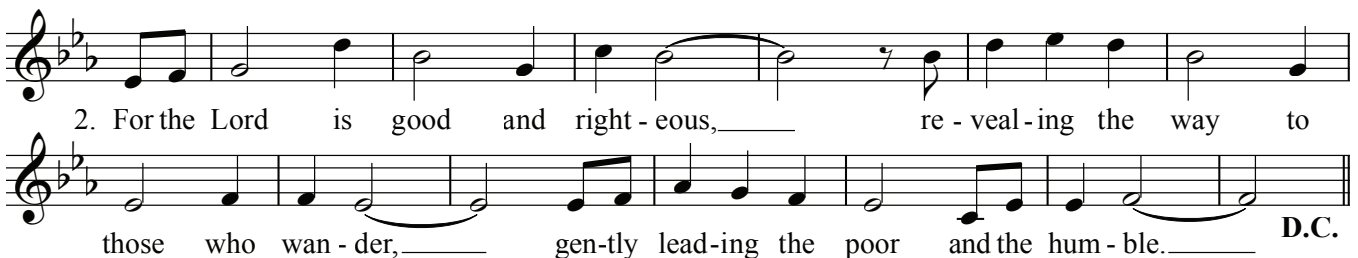
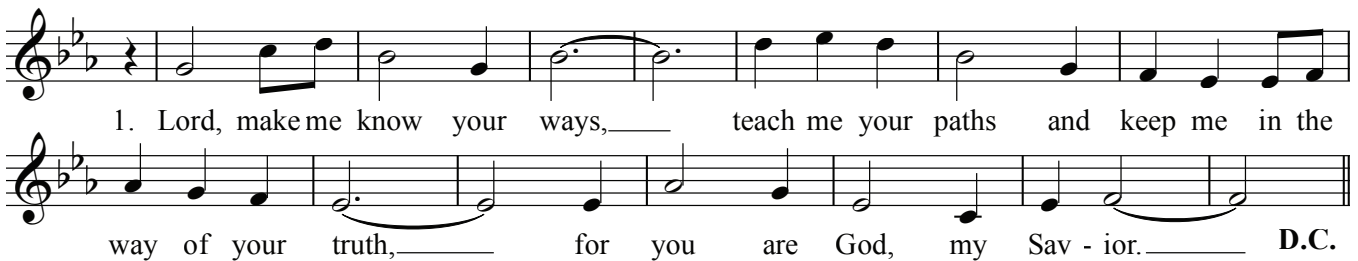

do not allow my enemies to laugh at me; for none who are awaiting you will be disappointed. *Psalm 25:1-7*

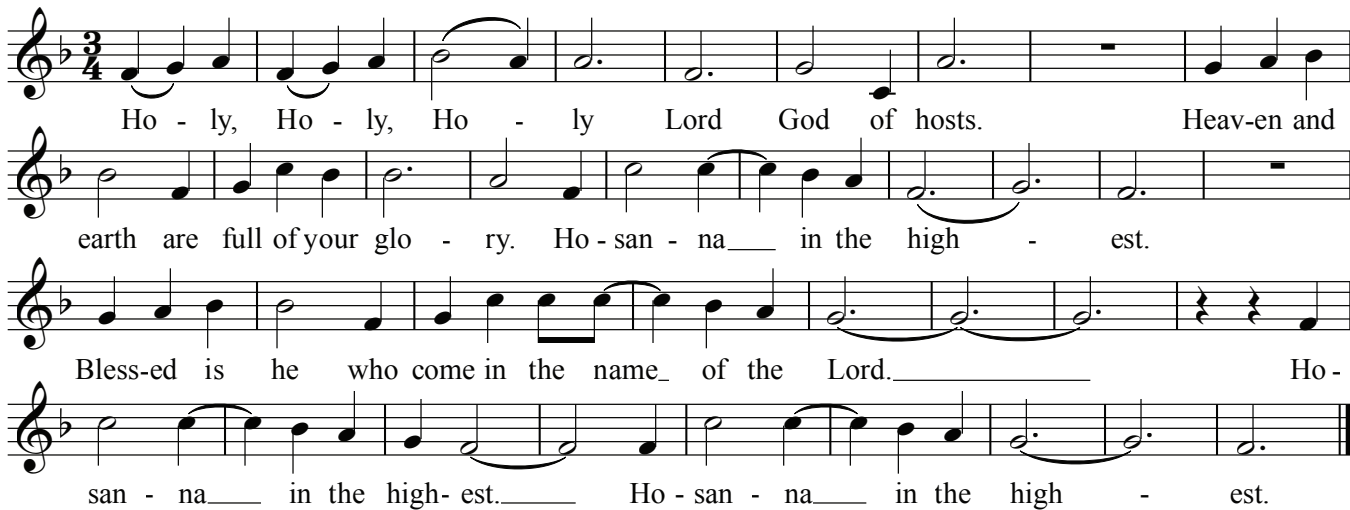

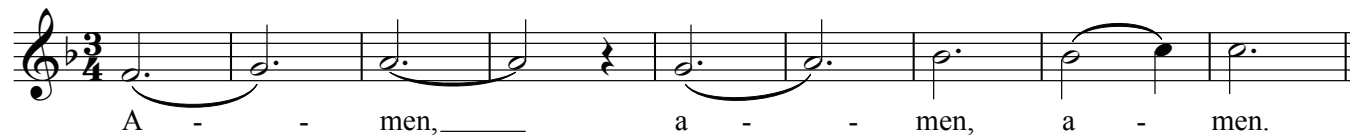

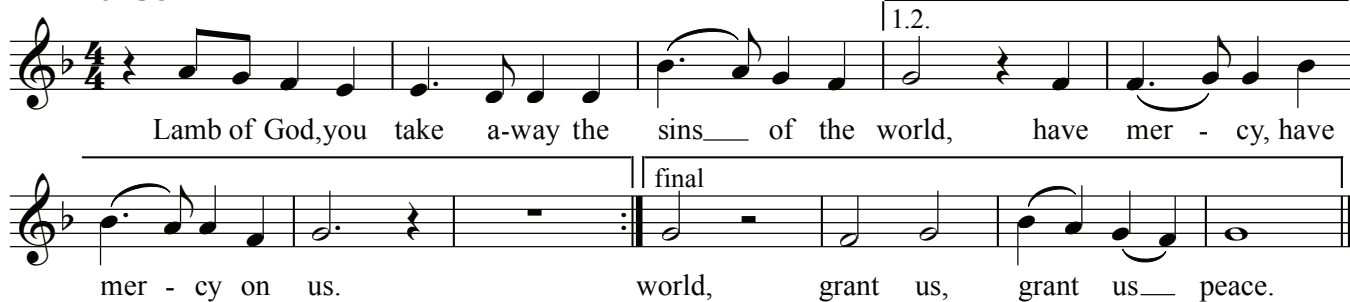
